Auto Scale Forms


Forms (screens) have a standard size, including font size. Auto scaling will set the form size to the size of the screen.

You can auto scale individual forms by pressing **Alt + Enter** buttons together.

You can also set the user file to always auto scale forms.

Livestock Office main menu > File > User File


- Display the user.
- Add a tick to the **Auto-scale Forms** option. Once set this will auto scale every form you open.
- You will need to log out and back in again for the change to take effect.

Troubleshooting

| Issue | Description |
|---------------------------------------|---|
| Form is smaller | Auto Scale will fit the form to screen. If the form is too big then it will scale it back to fit making it all small. If you make the form smaller by dragging from the corner then it will scale bigger to fit the screen. |
| Form scales different to another user | The scale of the form depends on the form size on the screen. Another user may have different settings, a different monitor and different options on the form. |
| Text lines are too large to read | Eg: <div data-bbox="462 793 1421 1014" data-label="Image">  </div> |
| Form is not any larger | Some display of text files do not scale well. Hit Alt+Enter to disable the auto scale while viewing the log. There are a couple of forms that do not auto scale. One of these is the Company Details form. |
