PAYSHR SUPPORT WILL END ON 1-4-2014

As we have mentioned in the last couple of newsletters, Microsoft have ceased their support for the programming language FoxPro, version 8 that the current PayShr programme uses. This means that if you update your computer, you may not be able to run PayShr on it.

With this in mind, we have spent the past 12 months developing a new Payroll / Cashbook program to replace PayShr. The new program is called PAYBIZ. It is a very comprehensive and flexible system designed specifically for contractors, especially Shearing contractors.

We have been testing the new programme over the past couple of months and fine tuning it to your needs.

Training material is being produced and we hope to start training sessions around the country in early November. We hope to have all our shearing contractor clients up and running on PayBiz by 1-4-2014.
